**TEST INFORMATION**

**The Test will commence at 9:00 AM.** Dogs may not be entered in more than one test level.  
Running order will be posted on Entry Express and at the site.

**Birds:** Ducks will be used at all tests.

**Prizes:** Qualifying dogs will receive a rosette ribbon. Qualifiers are eligible for Poodle Club of America, Inc. certificates. Artero is the Sponsor of the Hunt Events.

**Bitches in Season and injured dogs:** The test committee must receive scratches prior to the beginning of the stake entered. Bitches in season cannot run and are not allowed on the grounds. A full refund will be available for bitches in season or injured dogs with letter from veterinarian. PCA will not pay any entry service fees.

**Welcome Party:** On Friday evening, October 4, 2024, there will be a dinner at the Historic residence at the Donaldson Brown Conference Center at Mt. Ararat Farm. See Welcome Letter & Important Details.

**Directions to the Hunt Test Site:**

Take I 95 to Exit 93, 222 North, left at the Bainbridge Rd. (222), about 2 miles on your left is Mt. Ararat Farm Rd., follow to stop sign and take left onto Frenchtown Rd., look for the dirt road on the right, Frank Brown Lane.

**Food:** There is a Royal Farms and Subway within a few miles of the test location and numerous restaurants in the area. **Please note:** You will need to bring your own lunch.

**Reminders:**

- Please bring your own shade and water.
- Dogs must be on leash or confined when not running in test.
- Electronic collars are not permitted.
- Please keep cell phones on silent mode.

Please air/exercise your dogs away from the test location and those areas where there is likely to be foot traffic.

**PICK UP after your dog. No un-entered dogs loose, please.**

**24 hours prior to the start of the test, only the judges and hunt test committee will be allowed at the test site.**
