TEST INFORMATION

The Test will commence at 9:00 AM. Dogs may not be entered in more than one test level. The running order will be sent to each exhibitor and will be posted at the site.

Birds: Pheasants or Chukars will be used at all tests.

Prizes: Duck bands and ribbons for all qualifiers, Purina Pro Plan Small Towels offered by Pro Plan, Pro Plan Samples and Artero Shampoo and Conditioner (drawing to be held from among the qualifiers) offered by Artero USA Inc.

Bitches in Season and injured dogs: The test committee must receive scratches prior to the beginning of the stake entered. Bitches in season cannot run and are not allowed on the grounds. A full refund will be available for bitches in season or injured dogs with letter from veterinarian. PCA will not pay any entry service fees.

Directions to the Hunt Test Site:

- 1. From I-55 and IL-16 in Litchfield, IL, go east on IL-16 through Hillsboro, IL.
- 2. After passing the courthouse square, go left on 22nd Street (IL-16)
- 3. Go 1.2 miles and then turn left on Broadway.
- 4. After two blocks, go left at the T in the road, this becomes Lakecrest Trail.
- 5. Turn right on Lakecrest Lane. Crannie Mack headquarters is on the right.

Food:

Please note: You will need to bring your own lunch.

Reminders:

- Please bring your own shade and water.
- Dogs must be on leash or confined when not running in test.
- Electronic collars are not permitted.
- Please keep cell phones on silent mode.

BLAZE ORANGE CLOTHING IS REQUIRED FOR ANYONE ON THE HUNT TEST GROUNDS.

ILLINOIS RESIDENTS HANDLING DOGS OR SHOOTING GUNS must have a valid hunting license and habitat stamp.

Please air/exercise your dogs away from the test location and those areas where there is likely to be foot traffic. **PICK UP after your dog**. **No un-entered dogs loose, please.**

24 hours prior to the start of the test, only the judges and hunt test committee will be allowed on the grounds. There will be no training at the test location on the grounds 24 hours prior to the test date.

No training, correcting, or disciplining of dogs will be permitted on the Hunt Test Grounds. Please bring adequate water for your dogs and yourself. Be prepared to provide water for your dog while in the field. Smoking will not be allowed in the field.
