If either form of entry has not been filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either.

Entries may be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable.

No FAX or emailed entries will be accepted.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard. Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.

Please check your entries and confirmation!

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all Poodles fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Classes Offered

Regular Agility

STANDARD: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent, and Master JUMPERS WITH WEAVES: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent, and Master TIME 2 BEAT

Preferred Agility

STANDARD: Novice, Open, Excellent, and Master JUMPERS WITH WEAVES: Novice, Open, Excellent, and Master TIME 2 BEAT

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Tentative Running Order/Start Times

Class Order - Regular and Preferred will be run together at each height. Time 2 Beat Standard - Master/Excellent, Open, Novice JWW - Master/Excellent, Open, Novice Jump Order Small to Tall Start Times Walkthrough/judge's briefing 7:30 am Judging starts 8:00 am

Move-ups

MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CT, Monday, April 14. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Crating

There will be crating specific to agility and crating for agility continuing through Obedience/ Rally. Please check your confirmation notice for updated information.

Trial Information

Setup on Sunday will be 5:00 pm - 6:00 pm. Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion. Ring size: 80' x 120'.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

- The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space. Please bring chairs, crates and water for your dogs, and clean up supplies. All crates must be on mats.
- No strollers or playpens will be allowed in the building.
- NO SMOKING is allowed in the building.
- Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) may be brought into the Event Center.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- The Poodle Club of America (PCA) and Nestle Purina and their agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- The PCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression.

No one shall have any recourse or claim against the PCA or any official thereof.

The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fees for a bitch in season or for an injured dog, only upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a <u>\$20 returned check fee</u>. No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than or equal to \$4.

Checks for cancelled or incomplete entries will be shredded. No check will be returned.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The PCA has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u> <u>Agreement and Rules</u>. <u>Junior Handlers</u> must enter their JH# and complete back of form.

- <u>Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms</u>, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. <u>Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after</u> the closing date except as provided in the AKC regulations. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- <u>All dogs must be on leash or crated</u> at all times except when in the ring or in the designated agility warm-up area.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Flash photography is strictly forbidden at ringside and in the bleachers. Flash photography may constitute a danger to competing dogs and handlers. Consequently, persons failing to observe this rule will be asked to leave the Event Center and may be subject to disciplinary action.

Hign in Trial Regular Classes.....Clipper

High in Trial will be determined as follows. For dogs that have scores of 100 in the Master/ Excellent classes, the actual seconds under standard course time to the hundredth will be combined from both Regular Master/Excellent Standard and Regular Master/Excellent JWW classes, and similarly from Preferred Master/Excellent and Preferred Master/Excellent JWW classes. The poodle from each division with the highest points (seconds) will be HIT. HIT Overall will be awarded to the poodle with the highest points from Regular and Preferred.

For High in Trial Junior, High in Trial Champion, and the Peabody Award only qualifying scores from the Standard classes will be used. In the case of a tie, the winner will be determined by the highest amount of seconds under SCT. To be eligible for High in Trial Junior, the handler must have a valid AKC Junior Handler number.

High Scoring Open and High Scoring Novice Dog from the Standard classes will be determined by qualifying scores. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by the highest amount of seconds under SCT.

There will be an awards ceremony following Master/Excellent JWW.





Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete: however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
